## The Money Question Everyone Wants Answered

Here's where things get spicy. Various sources estimate the **Alan Keating net worth** anywhere between fifteen million and five hundred million dollars. That's not a typo. Here's the thing though. There is more than meets the eye when it comes to tournament results with Keating. This man gained fame in the cash games, which are the type of cash games where the pot in the game may be more than one may buy a house.

Keating won a one point seven million dollar pot in one of the largest livestream poker events in history in December 2025 to walk away with a profit of one point seven million dollars at the Million Dollar Marathon. It was a three-way cooler with a pot of over two million dollars where he was flopping a full house to two guys with trips.

But before you come to believe that he is a sort of poker machine that never stops, I will hit you with reality. His scores on games he livestream demonstrate that he has lost close to three million dollars in ninety-seven hours of gaming. His loss rate is approximately thirty thousand dollars per hour.

Alan Keating is a poker player who is either employing the smartest game plan in history or the most costly game, since he plays poker as though he does not care about money at all. We can look forward to gigantic pots, dubious calls that just happen to turn out, the internet boning out of its collective mind because someone thinks he is either a genius or he has just got a lucky break.

## The Verdict On Alan Keating Net Worth

So what's the real **Alan Keating net worth** in 2026? Judging by all we have observed, the most probable estimate is likely to lie on the middle of those extremes. He is not even making a living off fifteen million when he is willing to waste millions on a single sitting.
