Cam realized that it was not only his personality and worldview that could be of use in rapping. He created a brand new following of individuals who may not be familiar with Down and Out, but will tune in every week and listen to him dismantle basketball.

That is the type of proactive thinking that retains your salary. When your music royalties are getting low since streaming pays fractions of pennies, you need to have another pot going. Cam was in the entire kitchen.

## **Real Estate and Smart Investments**

Nobody really talks about this enough, but **Cam'ron net worth** includes some solid real estate moves. The man is a property owner in Harlem, i.e., the area that is being gentrified out of control over the last ten years? That's not coincidence. That is a person who has

realized that it makes generational wealth to purchase the land in your neighborhood before the area becomes hot.
