The Touring Economics Are Insane

No one speaks about how cruel and lucrative touring turns out to be. Future has been touring regularly since 2016. The Summer Sixteen Tour with Drake, the Nobody Safe Tour, Future Hndrxx Tour, Legendary Nights with Meek Mill the man does not rest. The latest events that continued to keep the cash flowing were the One Big Party Tour and the 2024 We Trust You Tour with Metro Boomin.

It adds up to 40-50 million a year of gross touring revenue when you are doing 40-50 dates annually and pulling a million per show. Of course, it costs, crew, production, travel, insurance but even then, there is some one who is making money off of touring on the level of Future.
