When Tyga started his OnlyFans, he raised a few eyebrows, and the rapper is laughing all the way to the bank with an estimated revenue of about 7 million per month. That is 84 million dollars a year on a single platform. He is blending music drops, special collaborations, and lifestyle content that makes subscribers continue to pay on a monthly basis.
