Snipes in 2008 was found guilty of three misdemeanors of not filing tax returns. He served almost 900 days in federal prison, and when he stepped out, he was greeted with a bill which later grew to up to 23.5 million in back taxes, penalties and interest.

Think about that for a second. The guy has lost tens of millions that used to be brought to him. That is not simply losing your fortune: that is literally bleeding to death.

## **The Negotiation That Didn't Really Help**

The government later accepted to pay the debt after years of litigation and appeals to the tune of 9.5 million. It is generous till you got to know that Wesley counter-offered with 842,000.
